Traditional Recreation

The Traditional Recreation program at Southeast Works allows individuals to attend events of their choice in the community. A monthly calendar is mailed and individuals choose what they want to attend. Each event has a nominal fee in order to cover staffing costs, transportation costs, as well as any event costs. On the day of the event individuals meet at Southeast Works and are greeted by staff accompanying them on the event.

Typical Events

- Festivals
- Movies and Plays
- Dining Out
- Arts and Crafts
- Various Sporting Events
- Swimming
- Bowling

Eligibility

Any individual with a developmental disability who goes through the intake process with the Recreation Coordinator.

After Work Recreation (Respite)

The After Work Respite Program is a unique respite program which begins when the individuals' programming day ends. At the end of the work day they join the respite staff and their peers for several hours of activities.

Typical Activities

- Exercising
- Shopping
- Eating Out
- Preparing Meals at Southeast Works
- Going to the Movies
- Craft Opportunities
- Bowling

Eligibility

All persons with developmental disabilities who are Home and Community Based Waiver enrolled through NYS OPWDD and are currently living with family or a caregiver.
